

# COACH REPORT JAN TO APRIL 10

THE 1<sup>ST</sup> 4 MONTHS OF 2010 HAVE BEEN VERY BUSY FOR BOTH SCUNTHORPE ANCHOR AND CASA. WE STARTED IN JANUARY WITH THE 1<sup>ST</sup> ROUND OF THE LINCS SENIOR LEAGUE. DUE TO ILLNESS CASA GREEN FIELDED A WEAKER TEAM THAN NORMAL BUT STILL MANAGED A CREDITABLE 3<sup>RD</sup> PLACE BY ONLY 3 POINTS. THIS WAS DESPITE EXTREMELY POOR JUDGING WHICH WOULD HAVE SEEN US IN 2<sup>ND</sup> PLACE.

FEBRUARY SAW US COMPETING AT THE YSA JUNIOR / SENIOR MEET WHICH SAW ANCHOR HAVING 9 SWIMMERS COMPETING. CASA HAD 13 FINALISTS WITH LAUREN YORK AND JASMIN KIRK CONTRIBUTING 4 OF THESE. THERE WAS ALSO 54 PB'S. THE FOLLOWING WEEK SAW THE 1<sup>ST</sup> ROUND OF THE BARNSELY LEAGUE WHICH SAW ANCHOR SWIMMERS GETTING 56 PB'S. THE NEXT 2 WEEKENDS SAW CASA COMPETING IN THE YSA BAGCATS. ANCHOR HAD A RECORD 28 QUALIFIERS THIS YEAR. WE HAD 96 FINALISTS AND WON 28 MEDALS. MORE IMPORTANTLY JACK NEWTON GAVE CASA THEIR 1<sup>ST</sup> AGE GROUP NATIONAL QUALIFIER IN THE 100 & 200 FLY.

THE 1<sup>ST</sup> ROUND OF THE JUNIOR LEAGUE TOOK PLACE AT THE BEGINNING OF MARCH. IT WAS PLEASING TO SEE THAT 75% OF THE A TEAM WAS MADE UP OF ANCHOR SWIMMERS. THIS IS TESTIMONY TO THE HARD WORK BEING PUT IN BY BOTH THE SWIMMERS AND THE COACHING STAFF. THE A TEAM WON THEIR GALA WITH THE VERY WEAKENED B TEAM COMING 4<sup>TH</sup>. THE B TEAM GALA WAS MARRED BY LINCOLN VULCANS ILLEGALLY SWIMMING UNDER AGE SWIMMERS. THIS MEANS THE NEXT ROUND WILL BE SWUM UNDER PROTEST AND WE ARE IN THE MIDDLE OF A COMPLAINT TO THE ASA. ALSO WE ACHIEVED 45 PB'S AND TOO MANY SPEEDING TICKETS TO COUNT.
