

Casa took quite a young squad to Coventry at the end of April for the Spring Open meet under the guidance of Cads club coach Nathan Hilton.

With several swimmers from the Scunthorpe side doing between one and fifteen races, it turned out to be one of their most successful meets. With several club records broken and improvements on National and District times, and with every swimmer making a least one pb on their entered long course time. Sophie Hame travelled all the way for the 10 years 200 frontcrawl improving her time by six seconds and obtaining her district time so a worthwhile journey.

New club records were achieved by many of the Anchor swimmers Jasmin Kirk took the club record in the 400mtr I/M and finished Top Girl in the 14 and over age group.

Josh Jones improved his 200-breast stroke National time to put him back on the top spot of the rankings for Nationals in July.

Casa took top club award at the end of two days an achievement that was echoed with the Top placed boys and girls. Holly Williams was placed 10th overall in the girls 10years age group with Caitlin Bower taking 3rd place in the same age group. Lauren York mirroring the same position of 3rd in the 13-year girls.

Joshua Jones was placed 3rd in the 11year boys and Kieran Skinner took the top slot.

Rhiannon Haber & Becky Moore also achieved good times in their six entered races with an improved pb for Rhiannon in the 400 mtr frontcrawl of 12 seconds, and Becky taking silver in both the 100 & 200 butterfly.

The weekend over all went to Kieran Skinner who took a total of four first places, five-second places and three 3rd places out of his fifteen swims. Kieran took at least two and a half accumulated minutes from all of his entered times which led Kieran to an amazing **Five** club records in the 50, 100, and 200 butterfly and the 200 backcrawl and 400 I/M. This put Kieran in a very favourable position for the impending age group Districts in a few weeks, with a total 12 swims the most achieved by any swimmer in recent times and certainly since Club Coach Dave Leeman took over. Kieran will also be taking on the heavy task of the 800 & 1500mtrs at districts I hope Dad will have a comfy seat?
